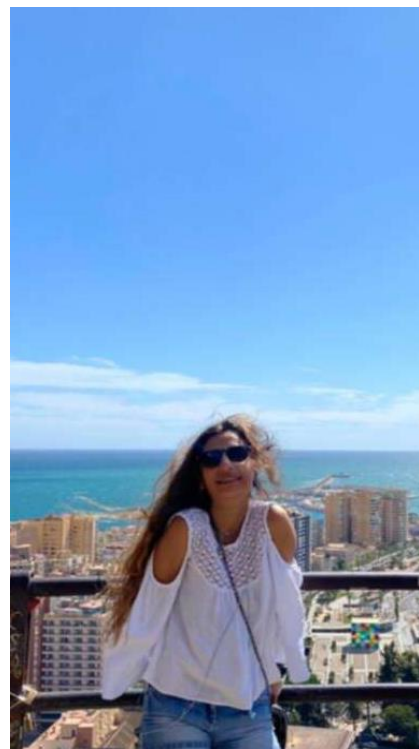

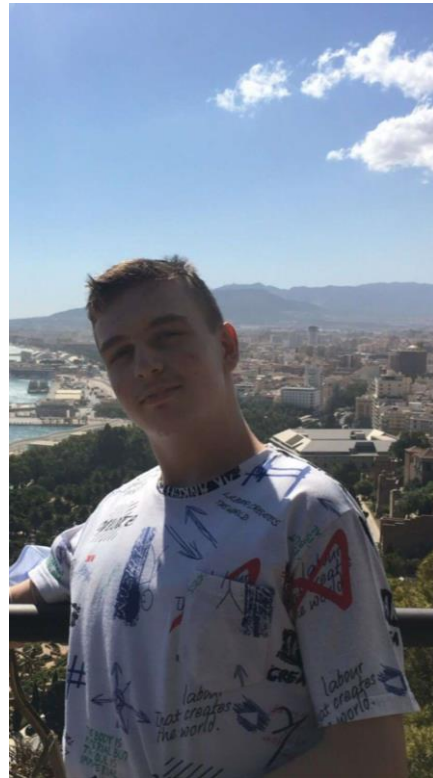

CULTURAL & LINGUISTIC PREPARATION

Cultural activities, Andalusian cities & places visited during the programme

Walk around Malaga city center: On the walk around Malaga city center the trainees were able to see Malaga's oldest parts and explore its history. Dating back to almost 800 BC, Malaga is one of the oldest cities in the world. The tour passed by ruins from The Roman, Moorish and Christian civilizations including The Roman Theatre, The Alcazaba, The Cathedral of Malaga and St. Johns Church.

Nerja: The city located on the eastern end of the Costa del Sol, has all of the elements needed to charm any visitor. Its annual average temperature of around twenty degrees Celsius, its beautiful mountain landscape of La Axarquía region, as well as its rugged coastline of beaches and cliffs, are just some of its attractions. Nerja has more than its fair share of fabulous beaches, Burriana and Torrecilla being the main ones, which boast 16 kilometres of powdery sand and sparkling clear water, and a splattering of small coves to explore. The old quarter of the town is still virtually unchanged with narrow, winding streets, whitewashed houses with wrought iron terraces overflowing with geraniums, on which a canary can sometimes be heard singing.
